- 1. Fire-resistant roofing materials
 - Class A Rated: Choose roofing materials with a Class A fire rating, which offers the highest resistance to ignition and flame spread. Examples include:
 - Asphalt/fiberglass shingles
 - Metal roofs
 - o Clay tiles
 - Concrete tiles
 - Slate


