FROM THE ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE:

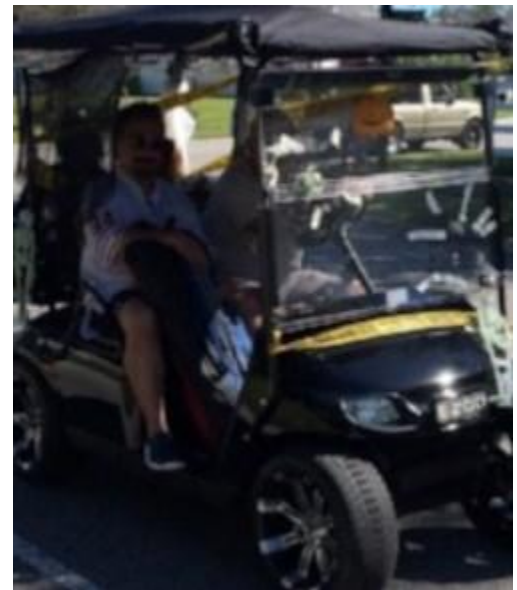
The committee hopes everyone had a wonderful Christmas, Holiday, and a safe New Year!
