Be kind to you neighbors - do not block the streets, other neighbor's driveways, or the intersections. Always walk your dogs on a leash, and please always clean up after them.

Please observe the Horry County Golf Cart laws. Do not drive Golf Carts on our neighborhood sidewalks or on common area grass.

GOLF CARTS

Please remember South Carolina Legislature Section 56-2-105 states that:

- A person operating a permitted golf cart must be at least sixteen years of age and hold a valid driver's license. The operator of a permitted golf cart being operated on a highway or street must have in his possession:
 - (1) the registration certificate issued by the department;
 - (2) proof of liability insurance for the golf cart; and
 - (3) his driver's license.

Please obey all pool rules to ensure a safe and fun experience while utilizing the swimming pools in the community. Below are a few reminders of the pool rules:

- The pools are for the residents use and enjoyment. Residents should use discretion when inviting a guest to use the pool. The number of guests will be limited to six per address and any resident wanting to invite seven or more guests to the pool must have the management company approval before entering the facility. Guests are only allowed pool usage when accompanied by a resident for the entire stay and all guests must be registered before entering the pool.
- The pool cannot be reserved or used for parties except for HOA approved events. All parties must be held in the amenity center and scheduled through the management company.
- All children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult during the child's entire stay in the pool area. Diapered children are not to be allowed in the swimming pool at any time. (Specific swim diapers permitted).
- The swimming pool is limited to residents and resident guests of The Farm at Carolina Forest. The pool opens at 9:00am and will be locked at 10:00pm.
- Bottles, glasses or glass objects will not be permitted in the swimming pool or pool deck area at any time. Broken glass can cause serious injury if glass should fall into the swimming pool, the result will be the closing of the pool for an extended period of time for draining and cleaning. For everyone's safety, it is requested that the Managing Agent be notified at once should any glass objects be seen in the pool area.
- Pneumatic floats or other paraphernalia of similar nature except for swimming aids, are not permitted in the pool area (Swimming noodles are permitted to be used by children).

****Any violation of the pool facilities' rules will result in the deactivation of the owner's access card.****
