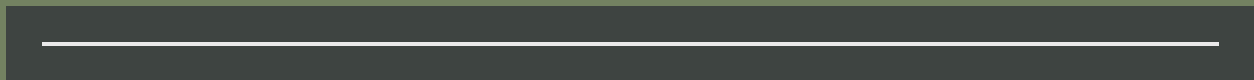

The ponds around the Farm have rocks (Rip Rap) placed around culverts and on the banks. These rocks are there to prevent erosion of the soil into the ponds. It has been noted that people are throwing these rocks into the pond and removing the rock. By doing this, it increases the cost to the community, because these rock need to be replaced. The average cost to the community is between \$2,000 and \$3,000 every time we need to replace these rocks. Please help maintain our ponds by not throwing the rocks into or removing the rock from the ponds. This is preventive maintenance to our ponds and without this maintenance our pond will eventually need to be dredged at an even greater cost to our community. If you see children or young adults throwing these rock into the ponds, please ask them to stop and explain that these rocks are there to protect our ponds. Thank you.

Pool Security will begin Friday, May 3rd. Please check your key cards as residents must have a valid working key card to use the pool facilities. Parents, just a reminder that children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times while at the pool. Please do not drop your children off at the pool unattended.
