POOL PROJECT UPDATE March 26, 2026

The three-pool project presented to the membership last year has been formally discontinued after the BOD considered community feedback.

Since that time, the BOD has consulted with multiple engineers and pool companies to evaluate the condition of the existing pool. In addition, a local retired engineer and member of the association, Paul Lavella, reviewed the engineering report and provided valuable recommendations. We extend our sincere thanks to Paul for his time and expertise.

Based on evaluations, the BOD has approved several pool repairs for this year, with the goal of extending the life and usability of the current pool. The engineer's primary recommendation is to repair the left portion of the pool shell.

The BOD will continue to obtain estimates from qualified local companies and will share updates and information with the association as they become available.



Pool season is almost here! We are excited to announce that our community pools will officially open on April 15th with daily hours from 9:00 AM to dusk. As we kick off another great season, we kindly ask all residents to take a few moments to refresh themselves on the community pool rules to help ensure a safe, clean and enjoyment for everyone.
